Our Mission

Shelter Movers is a national, volunteer-powered charitable organization providing moving and storage services at no cost to individuals and families fleeing abuse. We collaborate with local businesses and community agencies to support people, primarily women and children, as they transition to a life free of violence.

Intake & Coordination

Our Intake Team will reply to gather safety and logistical information. Next, a Move Coordinator will contact the client and begin coordinating resources (vehicles, volunteers, interpreters, security personnel, pet fostering) to support the move according to the client's needs and priorities.



Moving Day

A move team will accompany the client to pack, transport and store belongings at no cost. A Lead Mover will serve as the client's main point of contact throughout the move.

Moving Services



Urgent Exit

Moving a client from their current home to a shelter or safe space.



Escorted Move

Escorting a client to their former home with security accompaniment to retrieve their belongings.



Resettlement Move

Transporting a client and their belongings from a shelter to their new home.

FAQs

Do you store furniture for free?

Yes, we offer no-cost storage, space permitting, at several sites.

How much can you move?

We can move up to a two bedroom apartment, at times more.

Will you move children and pets?

Yes, we can accommodate transportation of children and pets.

Do you only serve women and children?

No, we serve all survivors of abuse, regardless of their background or identity.

How are you funded?

We rely primarily on individual donations, corporate partnerships, grants and fundraising events.

To request a move

Shelter Movers' service is available by referral. Referring agencies typically include: shelter staff, social workers, healthcare providers, community-based organizations and police. Shelter Movers does not currently accept self-referrals.

To access our service, referred clients must be moving as a result of past or present abuse. Abuse occurs in many forms, e.g. financial, physical, psychological.
